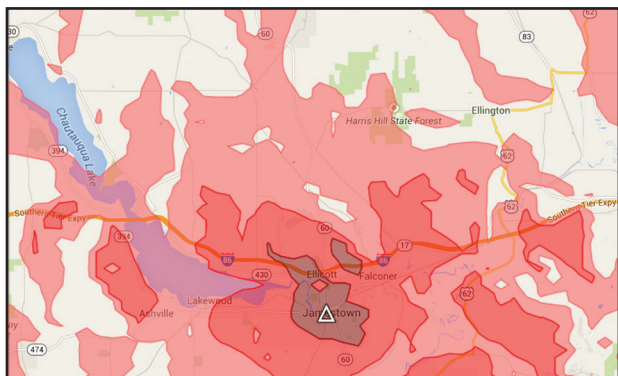
WRFA is dedicated to providing access to the arts, cultural and educational programming and a forum for the discourse of public affairs

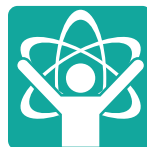

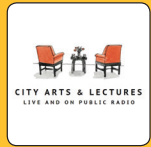

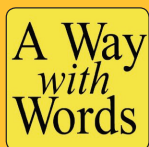
